This college fair is one of a series of similar events sponsored annually by the Carolinas Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers.

### TechMath program expands to county

TechMath, a three-year project linking businesses, teachers, and students from northeastern North Carolina, has expanded this fall to include Martin County and Martin Community College will serve as the program's training site for this area's participants.

Sponsored by East Carolina University and the National Science Foundation, the program brings ECU faculty members from the colleges of business and education together with high school teachers from Edgecombe, Beaufort, Martin, Nash, and Washington counties to develop lesson plans that focus on business-related science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) problems.

Participants will commit to at least 120 contact hours of work during the TechMath program, 80 hours of which will take place next summer during a workshop held at Martin Community College.
