MCC Spring Student Recruitment Underway

WILLIAMSTON, NC – Martin Community College (MCC)'s spring student recruitment period is currently underway with numerous school visits and campus tours scheduled throughout the month of March.

Student and faculty representatives from MCC's various programs visited area high schools last week to showcase the vocational and technical training opportunities available at the college. Four teams of MCC ambassadors, rotating locations over a four-day period, set up table displays and stood available to answer questions from prospective students about the over 20 curriculum programs offered by the college. The lunch time visits took place at Bear Grass, Jamesville, Roanoke, and Williamston high schools.

Close to 150 eighth-grade students from Perquimans County Middle School took a tour of MCC's campus facilities on Friday, March 14. Accompanied by their teachers and guidance counselors, the

students gathered in the college's auditorium for a brief presentation before taking a close-up view of academic life at a post-secondary school level. A number of current MCC students served as guides for this tour as well.

Guidance counselors and school officials from MCC's tri-county service area were on campus Monday, March 17 for a special "Counselor's Day" program and luncheon. The event, hosted by the college each year, is an opportunity to share news and updates on MCC's program areas and information about the degrees, diplomas, and certificates offered.

Summer registration for new and returning MCC students will be held on Thursday, April 3, from 8 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. The college's Bertie campus will hold its summer registration on Thursday, April 10, from 4-6 p.m.
