### MCC News: MCC Director to Participate in Symposium

Martin Community College (MCC) Emergency Services training coordinator Lee Black will participate in the upcoming Fifth Annual Eastern Regional Trauma Symposium to be held Friday, October 3, 2008 at the Greenville Convention Center. With presentations by regional and national expert faculty, this conference is designed to provide health care professionals with current clinical information on the diagnosis, treatment and management of patients with multiple traumas.

Invited by Pitt County Memorial Hospital (PCMH) Trauma Director Scott G. Segraves, MD, Black will join two PCMH staff members on a panel discussion about Emergency Medical Services (EMS) care in rural or difficult locations.

“I not only consider this invitation a great honor for me as a specialist in the field but also a great recognition of Martin Community College’s emergency services program standing within the health care community,” said Black.



Black is the only community college staff member serving as a guest faculty panelist and is featured alongside professors and directors from Brody School of Medicine, Yale University School of Medicine, and Shands at the University of Florida.

MCC’s EMS program, which includes Fire, Haz-Mat, and Rescue instruction, offers training to prepare individuals for various levels of EMS certification such as Medical Responder, Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), EMT-Intermediate, and EMS-Paramedics. In addition, current EMS personnel may enroll in several portions of the program to receive credit and maintain their existing certification.
