Applications for admission into the Associate Degree Nursing (A45110) program at Roanoke-Chowan Community College are due in the Spring Semester (Application opens November 1st and closes March 1st). Applications are hardcopy only and must be received at RCCC by the deadline. Only complete applications will be considered for acceptance into the program. Students will be advised by Martin Community College AGE Advisors about the application process and eligibility requirements.
