



Martin Community College COVID-19 Policy and Procedures for Students



- Masks will be worn while inside all campus buildings.
- Frequent handwashing and use of hand sanitizer will be highly encouraged in all classroom and laboratory spaces.
- Classrooms and labs will be arranged to maximize social distancing.
- If a student has been diagnosed with, or exposed to, COVID-19, they must call 252-789-0323 or text the COVID-19 helpline at 252-802-6116 and leave a name and number and you will receive a return call to discuss appropriate next steps.
- Following a Covid 19 isolation, no one may return to campus until they have been symptom free for at least 24 hours.
- Students who are not able to complete online classes or who do not wish to be face-to-face in a lab setting are encouraged to postpone their educational goals until such time they determine it to be safe for themselves to re-enter the college setting.
- Students who knowingly come to campus while sick, or return to campus without meeting the criteria to return are subject to disciplinary action.
