



Martin Community College COVID-19 Policy and Procedures for Students

- Masks are considered optional in all MCC Buildings, unless otherwise required due to exposure, quarantining, or post-isolation requirements.
- Frequent handwashing and use of hand sanitizer will be highly encouraged in all classroom and laboratory spaces.
- Social distancing is encouraged if and when possible.
- A student diagnosed with or exposed to COVID-19, must call 252-789-0323 or text the COVID-19 helpline at 252-217-4273 and leave their name and number. They will receive a return call to discuss the appropriate next steps.
- Following a COVID-19 isolation or quarantine, no one may return to campus before their designated return date.
- Students who are not able to complete online classes or who do not wish to be face-to-face in a lab setting are encouraged to postpone their educational goals until such time they determine it to be safe for them-selves to re-enter the college setting.
- Students who knowingly come to campus while sick, or return to campus without meeting the criteria to return are subject to disciplinary action.
