2021-2022 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Service Area High School Scholarships

Each of the high schools in the MCC service area will be provided with \$500.00 scholarship(s) for students to attend MCC during the 2021-2022 Academic Year. Upon satisfactory academic progress, these students will receive \$500.00 scholarships for the following academic year. The scholarships are awarded as follows: 1st year award is \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. 2nd year award is \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. The high school guidance officers will select the recipients through a competitive process at each school. Service area scholarships are only valid for the two years immediately following high school graduation.

Curriculum and Continuing-Education Scholarships

1. Automotive Systems Technology Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a second-year AST student. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

2. Milton Phelps Bennett Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a Martin County resident enrolled in a Career and Technical Education program. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

3. Clarence Biggs Continuing Education Scholarship

A needs-based amount for an adult student in a personal interest course. Awarded as a one-time sponsorship. (Varies)

4. Equine Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a second-year Equine student. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (2 Scholarships)

5. GED Free Class Certificate Scholarships

Provides up to three MCC credit hours (including fees) at no-charge for each GED graduate during the 2021-2022 Academic Year. (Varies)

6. E.M. Hunt Scholarship

A needs-based amount for students enrolled in a curriculum program equally over fall and spring. (Varies)

7. HVAC Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a second year HVAC student. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

8. Kitty and David Moore Scholarship

One-time award of \$1,500 for a student classified as a single parent. (1 Scholarship)

9. Ormond Family Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a 2021-2022 MCC GED graduate with the highest score who intends to attend MCC during the 2022-2023 Academic Year. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

10. A.B. Ayers Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a student who earned a GED from MCC and is enrolled in a Career and Technical Education program. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

11. Barnhill Scholarship

The amount up-to \$4000 for a full-time student from Martin County and has completed at least 12 credit hours in their program. Awarded as actual cost for the fall and spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

12. Bembridge Scholarship

One-time award of \$1000 for a student from the service area enrolled in the PTA program or the Nursing Assistant program. (1 Scholarship)

13. Boham Scholarship

One-time award of \$500 for a student from Bertie County and is enrolled in CTE or CE credential seeking program. (1 Scholarship)

14. Rogers Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a first-year Equine student. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

15. Epps Scholarship

A needs-based amount for tuition, books, and fees for any full-time student. (Varies)

16. Freeman Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a student from Martin County enrolled in the IT program. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

17. Hardy Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a second-year student enrolled in a business-related program. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

18. Newell Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for student who graduated from a Martin County high school and is enrolled in a two-year program. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)

19. Piephoff Scholarship

The amount of \$500 for a student from Martin County. Awarded as \$250.00 for the fall semester and \$250.00 for the spring semester. (1 Scholarship)
